If your company is interested in pursuing the Master Logger designation, you won't want to miss the next scheduled MLP certification course. This program, developed by the Washington Contract Loggers Association, requires completion of the four sessions listed below, plus first aid training, which is taught separately. Attendees may complete a partial MLP program, and take the remaining sessions at a later date. Attendees may also register for one or more days to earn continuing education credits (eight per day).

There is a new designation available in the Master Logger Program, called "Onsite Supervisor." Onsite supervisor is someone within your company who has completed the DNR Forest Practices class and first aid training, and is directly supervised by someone in your company that is a current Master Logger Professional. This new designation may be especially beneficial to those companies that operate multiple logging sides. In that, a company's Master Logger Professional(s) could potentially oversee multiple sites. Please note that you should check with landowners/land managers that you contract with to ensure that an "Onsite Supervisor" would be acceptable.
